





3.Safety Information

4.1 Usage Environment

- Use the product in indoor environment. Keep it away from heat and strong electromagnetic sources.
- Experience on seat is recommended. Avoid violent actions to prevent injury or damage to people or property.
- Place the product steadily and safely when you finish using to prevent drop.

WARNING: During use or storage, avoid direct irradiation from strong sunshine or other light sources on the lens lest the product be damaged.





4.3 Download and Install DPVR Assistant

- Go to DPVR official website www.dpvr.cn to download DPVR Assistant.
- Install DPVR Assistant by following the prompts.

4.4 Connect E3 to Computer



Method of setting audio output on the computer

1. Right click the sound icon in the lower right corner on the computer and choose "Player", then an audio setting window pops up;
2. In the audio setting window, choose the expectant sound output port (for example, "DPVR E3") and then click "Set as Default".
3. Please connect USB power port(USB 2.0) to 5V 2A power adapter if E3 screen black out. (Some of the mother boards' USB port can not provide 10Watt for USB power.)

4.5 Wearing HMD

For users without glasses, please directly wear helmet and adjust to a comfortable state.

For users wearing glasses, please wear the product as follows:




Figure 1: First put headset foam close to the glasses, and then pull the strap





Figure 2: Cover the glasses with the foam, loosen the strap, and adjust to a comfortable state

4.6 Adjust the strap

The strap of this product can be automatically adjusted by the built-in resilient structure according to the user's head circumference.

For those with large head circumference, please take off the Back Foam Cushion;

For those with small head circumference, please use the Back Foam Cushion if you feel the headset is falling.



4.7 Start experience

Start the DPVR Assistant. Check the headset connection status on the Device Connect pane.



5. Product maintenance

5.1 Replace the Face Foam Cushion


Over time, the Foam Cushion might be worn out. Replace it when necessary.

1. Carefully strip away the Foam Cushion from the nose area.
2. Install the Foam Cushion as per the illustrations below, and then gently press it onto the device.




5.2 Replacement for helmet cables

If it is necessary to replace the three-in-one cables or audio cables, after unscrewing the screws, use a small screwdriver to open the cable gland on the helmet, and unplug the original cables, then insert the new cables, finally cover the cable gland to screw back the screws.
